Frequency of the School Newsletter

This year the school newsletter will be published every week. One week will be an 'Update' and the following week will be a full newsletter to coincide with our Student of the Week awards/Whole School assembly. An email will be sent to each family's designated email account via our website on Saturday afternoons. Our newsletters are full of very important information and all parents are advised to read it.

Congratulations to our 2014 Kindergarten Children

Our youngest children commenced their schooling at St Bernadette's so beautifully. Congratulations to the children and their parents. A big thank you to our Kindergarten parents and families who have been assisting their little ones to transition to school. A reminder to all our Kindergarten parents that from Monday, 10th February the Kinder children will end their school day at 2.45pm along with all the other students.

Anaphylaxis

At St Bernadette's this year there are a number of children who experience anaphylaxis – in particular a severe allergic reaction when they are exposed to peanuts and nut related products. If those children are

exposed to these foods a severe allergic reaction can occur within 20 minutes of exposure and can rapidly become life threatening. Accidental exposure to these foods can happen at eating times and in the case of one of our students, the allergic reaction can be triggered when another person has touched or eaten these foods and then that person touches them. As a community we can assist these children by making our school environment safe. We ask families to:

- NOT use peanut, nut and chocolate spreads when making and sending sandwiches to school.
- NEVER send nuts to school for your own child to eat
- remind children NOT to share their food with other children at school
- explain to your children the seriousness of food allergies for those children who are affected by them and that we can help to keep these children safe by the choices we make.

Parking in and around the school

Please adhere to the school and parish guidelines for parking within the school and parish car park

- Entry to the car park ONLY from Brisbane Road

- DO NOT park in the Kiss 'n Drop area
- NEVER double park at anytime in the school grounds
- DO NOT drive through the car park at the bottom of the driveway closest to Brisbane Road
- Comply with the requests of volunteer traffic monitors and teacher supervisors as they monitor the smooth running of the 'Kiss 'n Drop' and 'Car Pick Up' services
- Obey parking signage
- Be mindful and vigilant at each pedestrian crossing in the car park

When we all work together we will be able to look after the safety of our precious children.






Award System at St Bernadette's

Library—General Information

The library is an educational centre for both students and staff. It is a valuable resource where children can study as a class, group or individuals.

The Library is open Monday to Thursday from 8.30 to 2.45pm. The library is supervised at lunchtime 1.20 to 1.40pm and the children may visit Monday to Wednesday. The Library is closed at recess.

Kindergarten	1 book at a time
Year 1 and 2	2 books at a time
Year 3 and 4	3 books at a time
Years 5 and 6	4 books at a time

Borrowing limits for children vary according to the child's grade:



Students visit the library once a week for Library lessons and borrowing, but may borrow more often if they are avid readers. <u>They must however return books before new ones can be loaned.</u>

- Students are encouraged to choose a suitable book themselves as this develops their tastes and skills. However this does not always occur. Please contact me if you are concerned.
- Borrowing is encouraged over the school holidays (excluding Christmas) for recreational reading.
- A Library bag is required by the children when borrowing.
- All books should be returned after 2 weeks.

Late Books

After the due date (i.e. 2 weeks after the book was borrowed) the book is overdue.

Books may be renewed if students need more time to finish reading the book.

Overdue notices are issued to students once per term.

Long term overdue notices are issued as a message to parents.

Lost or Damaged Books

If you think a book has been lost or damaged, please contact the library. We will:

- check the shelves to ensure that the item has not been returned. (It may not have been scanned or incorrectly scanned.)
- ask to check with your child's classroom teacher to make sure it is not in with the classroom books or reading books.
- request payment to replace the book.

Premiers Reading Challenge

All students are encouraged to participate in the **Premier's Reading Challenge**. The 2014 Challenge begins in March and finishes on September 1st, 2014. Many of the books listed can be borrowed from the **St Bernadette's School Library**.

Book Club

The Scholastic Book Club is run by the P&F once a term. The children have the opportunity to purchase books for information and recreational reading. Reward points from Book Club are used to purchase books for the classroom libraries.



Book club catalogues were sent home yesterday. All orders need to be returned to the office in an envelope clearly marked 'Book Club' by Friday, 14th February. Unfortunately orders cannot be accepted after this date. Thank you.

Child Protection

A reminder for parents who are required to 'UPDATE' their child protection and for 'NEW' parents to the school.



It is a Diocesan requirement that parents who volunteer at school must complete the CEO Online Child Protection Module. This training is available online at:

http://childprotection.parra.catholic.edu.au and **MUST** be completed every two years.

All parents must have completed the above prior to helping in the classroom, on excursions, sport days, tuckshop, uniform shop or any help around the school.



Application for Exemption From Attendance at School

Schools in the Parramatta Diocese have been informed that when families request to take their child(ren) out of school during term time it is necessary for them now to complete an **Application for Exemption From Attendance at School** form (**PRIOR** to taking your child out of school). This form can be downloaded from the school website (**PARENTS/NOTES FROM SCHOOL/ADMINISTRATION FORMS/STUDENT ATTENDANCE**). On completion, the form is to be sent to the school office so that a **Certificate of Exemption from Attendance at School** can be issued to parents. Parents are advised that when this certificate is issued they will need to have this with them during the period of exemption that has been granted. This certificate is a legal document. All applications for leave must be sent to the office 3 weeks prior to departure.

Term 4

If the absence is to attend a funeral, music or ballet exam then just a note of explanation to Mrs Nettleton is sufficient. Mrs Nettleton will then confirm the absence with a letter.

Birthday Cakes

If parents do need to send in a birthday cake for their child's birthday, teachers would prefer cup cakes.

This makes distribution in the classroom so much easier without the safety issues of bringing a knife into the class to cut the cake. Thank you.
