Dear Parents.

We live at a time when we have the most wonderful technologies available to us. We have the internet with its amazing breadth of interesting sites; we have phones, iPads, games, Facebook, Twitter, that are linked to it. But with all this comes a problem: how to handle all this in a non-addictive way? How not to allow these technologies to control our lives? Perhaps all this fits under the heading 'excess' about which Ron Rolheiser, columnist and author, has this to say: "Excess is a substitute for genuine enjoyment".

We go to excess in things because we can no longer enjoy them simply. It's when we no longer enjoy a drink that we drink to excess; it's when we no longer enjoy a simple party that we let things get out of hand; it's when we no longer enjoy the taste of chocolate that we over-indulge.

Excess isn't just a substitute for enjoyment, it's the very thing that drains all enjoyment from our lives; every recovering addict will tell us that. So, how do we prevent our children from slipping into the world of excessive behaviours? For the most part, children don't know what 'excess' is, unless adults introduce them to it. If a child is excessively involved with computer games and the like, maybe it's because of loneliness: no one has the time or interest to provide options such as belonging to a sports team, music group, hobby club, being involved in home cooking, gardening, board games, maybe visiting the local library or local park.

Children can learn about 'excess' by observing the behaviours of adults who might have succumbed to the pressures of life and so consume more, buy more, drink more, spend more than they should and genuinely substitute excess for enjoyment. Life to be enjoyable needs to be fairly simple. Perhaps the mantra of Author Mary Jo Leddy has wisdom to offer us:

"It's enough. I have enough. I am enough. Life is enough. I need to gratefully enjoy what I have."

Child Protection

A reminder for parents who are required to 'UPDATE' their child protection and for 'NEW' parents to the school.



It is a Diocesan requirement that parents who volunteer at school must complete the Child Protection Module ONLINE. This training is available online at:

http://childprotection.parra.catholic.edu.au/training and MUST be completed every two years. This is the new link as of September 2014.

All parents must have completed the above prior to helping in the classroom, on excursions, sport days, tuckshop, uniform shop or any help around the school.

CEDP - Diocesan Fees Schedule 2015: Summary

Annual Diocesan Tuition Fees - 2015

Annual Diocesan Tuition Fee can be paid upfront at the start of the year or as three equal payments in Terms 1, 2 and 3. The fee is only charged for the first three (3) children currently enrolled in the diocese (in other words there is no additional Diocesan Tuition Fee for the fourth child attending a systemic school in the diocese or other participating Catholic schools - see 'Sibling Discounts' below). To work out how much the fee is for each child, check the table below.

Annual Diocesan Building Levy - 2015

All families with one or more children in a Parramatta Diocesan school or at St Dominic's College, Kingswood are required to pay the annual Diocese of Parramatta Diocesan Building Levy. The levy for 2015 is \$702 per family, payable in three equal instalments of \$234 payable in terms one, two and three.

Annual Diocesan Education Fee Temporary Residents - 2015

The Diocesan Education Fee Temporary Residents for 2015 is \$1,731 per student, payable in three equal instalments of \$577 in terms one, two and three. The fee applies to new students on the following Visa numbers: 173, 401, 411, 415, 416, 418, 419, 420, 421, 422, 423, 426, 427, 428, 442, 457, 459, 476, 485, 497, 580, 600, 601, 651, 675, 676, 679, 685, 944, 956, 976 and 977 including where any of these are the preceding visas for families on bridging visas 010 to 090. Families charged this fee in 2013 will continue to be charged on a per family basis to the eldest student whilst the family has continuous current students.

REMINDER: for student absences

Application for Exemption From Attendance at School

Schools in the Parramatta Diocese have been informed that when families request to take their child(ren) out of school, for more than 3 days, during term time, it is necessary for them now to complete an **Application for Exemption From Attendance at School** form (**PRIOR** to taking your child out of school). This form can be downloaded from the school website (**PARENTS/NOTES FROM SCHOOL/ADMINISTRATION FORMS/STUDENT ATTENDANCE**). On completion, the form is to be sent to the school office so that a **Certificate of Exemption from Attendance at School** can be issued to parents. Parents are advised that when this certificate is issued they will need to have this with them during the period of exemption that has been granted. This certificate is a legal document. All applications for leave must be sent to the office **3** weeks prior to departure.

If the absence is to attend a funeral, music or ballet exam then just a note of explanation to Mrs Nettleton is sufficient. Mrs Nettleton will then confirm the absence with a letter.
