Welcome back to school. Our ANZAC Day Youth Ambassadors, Sam Hennessy and Emily Matthews, attended two ANZAC Day ceremonies at which they spoke about the ANAZAC tradition and read a poem reflecting on the ANZAC spirit.

I am sure that most of you were also captivated by the visit of our young royals, William and Kate and little baby George. Then on the last Sunday of the holidays we were treated to the unprecedented occasion of the canonization of two Popes in the presence of two living Popes. All in all, a very special holiday period!

On the occasion that has been dubbed by the media as the "day of four popes", Pope Francis reflected on our two newest saints. Pope St. John Paul II and Pope St. John XXIII:-

"These were two men of courage, they bore witness before the Church and the world to God's goodness and mercy. Even when faced with tragedy and suffering, the two new saints were brave.

They were priests, bishops and popes of the twentieth century. They lived through the tragic events of that century but they were not overwhelmed by them. For them, God was more powerful. John Paul II and John XXIII conveyed hope and faith, even in dark times. John XXIII was a pope who was open to the spirit. John Paul II was a leader and protector of the family."

This term is a very short one—only 9 weeks. As usual though, we have many activities planned for the children's on-going learning and many opportunities organized for our parents and families to come together.

#### **Diocesan Works Fund Appeal**

During the month of May, we will be joining all schools and parishes in the Diocese of Parramatta to help support the Diocesan Works Fund. We have launched this initiative by hosting a Gold Coin Mufti Day on Friday. Over the coming weeks the children will learn about some of the ministries and people it supports. Also known as faith @work this fund reaches out to people in our local communities that are not supported by regular parish contributions.

On Friday the eldest child in each family brought home a collection envelope with a letter to parents about the Appeal. Bishop Anthony Fisher has written his letter on the back of the Giving Envelope to you and other members of the Catholic community across Western Sydney to ask for everyone's support.

The faith@work appeal gives us the opportunity to act together as one Church family to support ministries and services that no individual parish or school can offer. Of particular interest is Blacktown Neighbour Aid service, which assists the frail, aged, people with a disability and their carers in our community; and the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) which trains religious education teachers who give witness to their faith in public schools in Western Sydney.

Your contribution enables services such as Blacktown Neighbour Aid, CCD and Catherine Villa (supporting homeless mothers aged 16-25) to respond to more people in need. Please be generous so these good works can continue.
