CANTEEN NEWS

As a result of a requirement from CEDP to renew our canteen tender process, from Term 2 our canteen service will be provided by Total Canteen Solutions. The



transition from Wendy's catering to our new providers will take place during the school holidays with the canteen operating from the first day back in Term 2.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Wendie s and her staff particularly Susan Walkerden (past St Bernadette's parent) and Sally Roznicki for their friendly service to our children over the years. I would also like to thank the many parents who have volunteered their time in the canteen and to those parents who have organised the Canteen Rosters most recently Mrs Daly and Mrs Khoudair. An agreement of the new tender is that parents will no longer need to offer assistance in the canteen employed staff will do this. I am sure that you will agree that this will be a burden lifted from families in a time when it is difficult to meet competing demands of work and school.

As you would expect with a new provider there will be some changes gradually introduced in the canteen. One of these will be the use of an online ordering system (cash will still be accepted for orders and over the counter purchases). Another will be a change in menu - our school leaders and representatives from the P&F conducted a menu sampling and were most impressed with what was on offer from Total Canteen Solutions. A new canteen menu will be posted on the school website during the holidays in preparation for Term 2 and in the first week back the menu will be emailed to families. Instructions about online ordering will be communicated to you as they become available.

Winter Uniform

The changeover time for Winter Uniform is by the commencement of Week 3 – Monday 9 May. However as it is hard to predict what the weather will be like, children can commence wearing the winter uniform from Week One if it is cool.
