On Thursday 27th, St Bernadette's Staff's Spirituality Day, was spent with the Biblical Scholar Dr Edward Sri.

Dr Edward Sri is a theologian, author and wellknown Catholic speaker. Each year he speaks

regularly to tens of thousands of people from around the world, including clergy, parish leaders, catechists and laity.

On Thursday Edward Sri led us through the Gospel of Matthew which will be the Gospel focus for Cycle C of the Liturgical Year in 2020. He presented a faithful exploration of Jesus' "kingdom-building" mission. Edward Sri explored the teaching and mission of Jesus Christ as revealed in

the New Testament and made connections to the Jewish roots in the Old Testament.

He delved into Matthew's gospel to reveal Why is the kingdom at the heart of Jesus' teaching? What were Jesus' contemporaries expecting? What did Jesus actually say about His

kingdom? What is the relationship between the 'kingdom' and the Catholic Church we see today?

Notification Policy if Moving from St Bernadette's

Please note: If you are leaving St Bernadette's please ensure you are aware that the Diocese requests a full terms notice, (10 school weeks) in writing, to be given to the Principal before a parent/guardian terminates a student's enrolment. According to Diocesan policy, if the required notice is not given, the parent/guardian is to pay one term's school fees including diocesan fees. Upon withdrawal of a student, fees are calculated on a pro-rata basis according to the notification period given. One exception is that notice in writing, will be accepted at anytime during Term 4. This is outlined on the last page of your Term 1 school fee account statement and also on the enrolment form instructions Please contact the school office if further clarification is required.
