A crowd of thousands gathered before dawn at the Centenary of Anzac Reserve in Kellyville to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice.

Anzac Day on 25 April is one of Australia's most important national occasions. It marks the anniversary of the first major military action fought by Australian and New Zealand forces during the First World War. Anzac Day goes beyond the anniversary of the landing on Gallipoli in 1915. It is the day on which we remember all Australians who served and died in war and in operational service. The spirit of Anzac, with its qualities of courage, mateship and sacrifice, continues to have meaning and relevance to our sense of national

Our school Leaders represented our school community at the Dawn service and our Captains laid a wreath on behalf of the school.

Our leaders heard Year 11 students who were chosen from local high schools as 2019
Secondary School Anzac Ambassadors, speak confidently and passionately about the impact of the Battle of Binh Ba, a battle that took place during the Vietnam War. Then they heard Commander Paul Garai, give the address, comparing his experiences in the Australian Navy today with that of his brother who served in the Vietnam War. The commander spoke about the courage of those who served during the war. It was a great experience for our young people to not only be at the Dawn Service but to also hear of the experiences of service men and

women and to witness young people speak with passion and poise at a public event.

Our leaders also assisted in leading the school ANZAC prayer liturgy on

Monday for our school community.


Who is eligible?
