Although we normally receive this sacrament after First Communion, the Church considers it to be the second of the three sacraments of initiation as it

The introduction to the

School Fees

Child Protection—Online

A reminder to parents that it is a diocesan requirement that you must have completed the Child Protection Module ONLINE if you would like to volunteer at school. The link for the child protection module is available below or from our website (right hand side). Please note there are <u>two</u> steps to complete the online course. http://childprotection.parra.catholic.edu.au/volunteers All parents must have completed the above prior to helping in the classroom, on excursions, sport days, in the uniform shop or any other help around the school. An email confirmation of both steps is then sent directly to the school to confirm your child protection is completed and valid for two years. Thank you for your cooperation.
